### ADDITIONAL INFORMATION ABOUT TRANSCRIPTS:

**Note: If courses are awarded pass/fail, the "pass" grades will be awarded a D.**

1. If a college-bound student-athlete took a dual-enrollment course (college/other nontraditional program), it must be on the home school transcript with a grade and high school equivalent credit awarded. The home school evaluator will award:

- 1.0 unit for one-full year;
- 0.5 unit for a semester;
- 0.34 unit for a trimester; and
- 0.25 unit for a quarter.

The above dual-enrollment course credit will apply unless other credit is awarded by the home school administrator on the home school transcript. Please refer to grade 12 for an example.

2. If a course has more than one textbook, please attach an additional textbook list. For assistance, please see the textbook list example and other information located on the Home School Resource page of the Eligibility Center Web site.

3. Below is an example of what is needed for a grading scale (please provide the grading scale on a 100-point range):
