Coach Hugh Greer's basketball team continued to break records this past season as it accumulated a record of wins numbering eighteen and five losses. The mark of 18 victories is the highest number of victories ever posted by a University of Connecticut five in one season, the previous high being 16 wins last season. The Huskies also ran their two season streak of wins to 16 before tasting defeat at the hands of NYU.

By virtue of six wins and one loss in Yankee Conference play, the U-Conn's won their official first title in that conference. Rhode Island's Rams were a close second with five wins and one loss in conference play.

The season's team total of 1223 points is the greatest number of points ever amassed by a Connecticut team. Their average of 53.1 points per game against 45.0 for their opponents shows a definite edge over their opponents and is indicative of fine defensive work.

Co-Captain Joe Maloney of Bridgeport led the Husky scoring with 255 points, closely followed by Stan Sorota of Willimantic with 206 points. For Coach Hugh Greer it was a great addition to last year's record when he took over from Blair Gullion and posted 13 victories and one defeat. His college record now stands at 31 victories and 6 losses.

Co-Captain Jally Luchuk of New Haven had the dubious honor of committing the most personal fouls, 70, but that was offset by his fine performance from the free throw line where he sank the most charity tosses, 55, and led the team per centage wise here with a mark of .670. Little Stan Sorota committed the least number of personal fouls, 37.
