UA -- Standerling strikes out swining for first out. Redondo pops out to catcher for second out. Gauthier flies out to left for third out.

UNLV -- Reimche singles to left. Leffler sac's (3-4), Reimche advances to second. Parris grounds out (1-3) Reimche reaches third. Moreno grounds out (4-3).

UA -- Jones singles. Jones reaches second when catcher attempts pick-off, but second baseman fails to make catch and tag. Error on Reimche. Lady flies to left first out. Miller pops out to second for second out. Guise fouls out to catcher.

UNLV -- Corniel grounds out (6-3). Baker singles to right. Benjamins reaches on fielders choice, catchers throw two second not on time. Zenjadunn pinch runs for Baker at second base. Swanson lines to second for second out. Spencer grounds out (1-3)

For UNLV 0 runs, 1 hit, 0 errors, 1 LOB

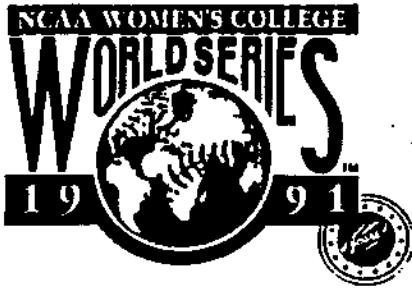
Fifth Inning UA 0 UNLV 0

HEAD COACHES QUOTES

UNLV COACH SHAN MCDONALD

On the game -- "When you get to the College World Series you expect to be in for a good ballgame. People come to see a good game and that's what they got tonight. It will be tough to match that one."

On Arizona -- "We went 1-1 against them during the regular season. The first one went extra innings like tonight's game which goes to show that this is a very competitive series. Both pitchers did a really good. We asked a lot of them (both teams) by having them go the distance."

On the next game -- "Luckily they set it up to where you have to lose two games so we're going to come out and give it our all tomorrow in hopes of coming away with a win. I don't think our kids are going to start hanging their heads because they realize that they're still in this thing."

ARIZONA COACH MIKE CANDREA

On the game -- "It was a great ballgame. We had some chances to score and they also had some chances. The game could have gone either way. We were very fortunate to win this one."

On the pitching performance of Debbie Day -- "The longer it went, the better she got, the more intense she got and the harder she threw. We feel very fortunate to walk out of this with a victory."

On the out at home plate (9th inning) -- "I would have done it again. I thought it was a good gamble. You can't wait for a clean base hit in a defensive battle like this one. The second baseman made a heads up play. If she's not alert, we score a run."

On the winning RBI -- "Jody (Miller) was struggling and frustrated throughout the game. I told her to look for her to pitch away. She looked for a pitch away and got it. The ball just finds a hole some-times."

On the team -- "The kids are playing very well. Mentally, they're as good as they've been at the College World Series. Last year I felt we just came here and choked."

On UCLA -- "We're looking forward to the challenge. The UCLA game will be a good game. We'll need great pitching and defense and we can't give them any opportunities. It should be a good matchup."
