

NCAA Division II Dead Periods in Sports Other Than Football and Basketball

June 1, 2009 through May 31, 2010

(See NCAA Division II Bylaw 30.11 for complete listing of recruiting calendars)

[Note: During the dead period immediately preceding the initial National Letter of Intent signing date, the National Letter of Intent cannot be hand-delivered; it must be mailed.]

Field Hockey, Soccer, Cross Country/Track and Field, Men's Water Polo	February 1 (7 a.m.) through February 3, 2010, (7 a.m.) (during the 48-hours prior to 7 a.m. on the initial date for the spring signing of the National Letter of Intent).
Men's Lacrosse	November 9 (7 a.m.) through November 11, 2009, (7 a.m.) (during the 48-hours prior to 7 a.m. on the initial date for the fall signing of the National Letter of Intent). December 9 through December 14, 2009, (the Wednesday before the Intercollegiate Men's Lacrosse Coaches Association Clinic through Monday following the clinic). May 27 through June 1, 2010, (Thursday before the NCAA Division II Men's Lacrosse Championship through noon Tuesday after the championship).
All Other Sports Exception: U.S. Diving National Championships (Bylaw 30.11.4.1.1)	November 9 (7 a.m.) through November 11, 2009, (7 a.m.) (during the 48-hours prior to 7 a.m. on the initial date for the fall signing of the National Letter of Intent). April 12 (7 a.m.) through April 14, 2010, (7 a.m.) (during the 48-hours prior to 7 a.m. on the initial date for the spring signing of the National Letter of Intent). When the dead period for recruiting occurs during the U.S. Diving National Championships, it shall be permissible to observe prospects participating in that event.
