## Highlights

**North Central returns to Division III victory podium:** Approaching the final turn, Kyle Brady flashed a smile towards the stands and his teammates on the North Central (IL) men's track and field team.

Behind him was widening a gap; ahead, open track and the finish line.

Also ahead of him: not one national title, but two.

Brady, a senior, pulled away from the field with a strong finish in the men's 5,000 meters. In so doing, he not only won the individual national title, but he essentially clinched the Cardinals' men's team title March 13 at the NCAA Division III Indoor Track and Field Championships at DePauw's Hollenmeister Track.

"I looked over and saw all my North Central guys, and that's one thing we really strive on at North Central, is team," Brady said. "I couldn't have done this without any of them."

North Central, which also won the meet-ending 1,600-meter relay (Jon Howard, Jon Caron, Dayton Henriksen and Dan Benton) in a time of 3 minutes, 17.22 seconds, won the men's competition with 52.3 points, well ahead of Wisconsin-Stevens Point (34), Wisconsin-La Crosse (31.5) and Wisconsin-Oshkosh (31).

The final day of the meet also featured a meet individual record.

Delannie Spriggs, a senior from Salisbury, set a track record in the preliminaries of the men's 55-meter dash, then continued a memorable day in the finals, winning in a Division III season-best and meet-record 6.20 seconds.

Spriggs ran a 6.26 in the preliminary and, after watching tape of the race, felt as if he let up late.

"My goal was to win," he said. "Records are made to be broken and you can't take championships away, but I felt like I had the record in me."

North Central - which also got eight key points from junior Dan Benton's second-place finish in the 400-meter dash and a tone-setting 20.3 points in the pole vault - sensed a chance at victory March 13.

Throughout the 5,000, each time Brady entered the final turn, North Central chanted, "N-C-C, N-C-C," and two laps from the finish, Brady - who finished eighth in the event as a junior - moved toward the lead. He moved into first on the final lap, and a strong finishing kick on the backstretch gave him a solid lead entering the final turn.

"I'm not out there alone," he said. "I'm out there with my 45 teammates, all the fans and all the family that's out there. It makes it a lot easier knowing you're not out there alone."

"That (a national title) is what I was racing for today - all year, all season, today. We just wanted to go out there and compete and do the best we can. It worked out pretty well."

Longtime North Central coach Al Carius makes a point to emphasize team.

"That's what we said last night on the bus, 'This truly is a track and field team,'" Carius said. "We really had a complete track and field team here. You get here and you might have two or three guys and we had about 15."

"Everybody really has contributed to the process. This was a delightful outcome for us."

Also in the Division III track events March 13:

\* Junior Nick Guarino, Fredonia State, won the men's mile in a Division III season's best 4:09.99.

\* Greenville senior Edgar Townsend won the men's 55-meter hurdles despite his shoe breaking seconds before the start of the finals. An official gave him a piece of tape, after which he won in 7:46 seconds. "I was worried worried - real worried," said Townsend, who also won the outdoor national championship in the event last season.

\* Ben Zill of Wisconsin-Oshkosh won the men's 400 meters with a Division III season-best 48.33.

\* Junior Aron Kehoe of Wisconsin-Whitewater won the men's 800 meters in 1:52.59.
